Purpose

The Jump Start Program is a mentorship initiative aimed to assist female students in their senior years of high school in obtaining a deeper understanding of what the Built Environment has to offer. With the inclusion of interactive workshops, panel discussions, site walks and informative mentoring sessions, this program provides a holistic view of what a career in the construction industry entails.

TARGET

This program is targeted at Year 10-12 female students within the North Sydney Catchment area that have expressed a desire in Construction Management, Architecture and/or Engineering.

SCOPE

The Multiplex Women spearheading this initiative are based in North Sydney on the One Denison Street Project, and have created this mentoring program in hopes of informing young females on the vast opportunities within the Built Environment. The program will begin with a presentation to the Year 10-12 female students in neighboring schools. This will be followed by a site walk at the Multiplex One Denison St Project in North Sydney, which has proven to be one of North Sydney's most iconic projects to date. It will be the new headquarters for Nine Network and the tallest building within this region. This site walk presents such a rare opportunity for these students to experience and see the creation of this iconic building.

Following this walk, the female Multiplex employees will offer ongoing support to the students who are eager to learn more and be involved in the program. Our team will mentor these students and provide insight on university life, work life and the industry. This will occur through various mentoring sessions, panel discussions and interactive workshops.
